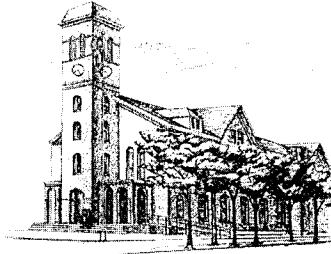

Proclamation of Disaster Emergency

WHEREAS, ongoing monitoring and projections made at our direction by the National Weather Service have disclosed that Hurricane Sandy is going to strike the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the County of Clearfield;


WHEREAS, Hurricane Sandy has the potential to cause widespread and heavy rains and high winds throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, which in turn poses a serious threat of flooding and other adverse impacts throughout the Commonwealth and Clearfield County;

WHEREAS, Hurricane Sandy's potentially heavy rains, high winds, and risk of flooding may result in extensive damage to roads, streets, bridges, private homes, businesses, and may cause other adverse impacts upon the general population of Pennsylvania and Clearfield County;

WHEREAS, these storm conditions have the potential to cause extensive power outages, road closures, community public safety delays, property damage and other significant adverse impacts throughout the Commonwealth and Clearfield County;

NOW THEREFORE, We the Commissioners of Clearfield County proclaim the existence of a disaster emergency in the County of Clearfield and hereby direct that all available County resources and personnel be applied to mitigate this emergency situation affecting Clearfield County.
