Crash Synopsis:

On 05/29/2024 at approximately 1234 hours, Unit 1 was traveling South on SR 322, Boggs Township, Clearfield County, PA. As Unit 1 was traveling South, Unit 1 was attempting to negotiate a right-handed curve in the roadway. Unit 1 traveled straight in the turn crossing the Northbound Lane, Unit 1 hit an embankment with its undercarriage before traveling up the embankment striking a tree with its front Unit 1 then overturning onto its passenger side facing North off the Eastern berm. Unit 1 was disabled and needed towed from the scene.
