Crash Synopsis:

This crash occurred on September 28th, 2024, on State Route 729 in Ferguson Township, Clearfield County. It occurred when Unit 1 failed to negotiate a right curve in the road while traveling north. Consequently, Unit 1 veered off the shoulder of the southbound lane and overturned into an embankment. Due to damage sustained at the nine o'clock position on the vehicle, Unit 1 was rendered inoperable. The operator of Unit 1 was transported to Penn Highlands Clearfield for a medical evaluation.
